Understanding and organising the decision:

- ____ Be clear on what decision you need to make
- Generate multiple options don't just settle on the first option you come to
- Consider other options to address the problem
- Identify who can help provide input or perspective on the decision

Preparing to make the decision:

- Don't rush make time to gather information and make a good decision
 - Gather the information you need to choose between the options
 - Understand your bias we all have biases and think whether you have a bias towards one option

Making the decision:

- Set aside proper time to make the decision research suggests mornings are better for most people
- Think about the pros and cons of each option and the importance of each one
 - Think how you'd advise someone else faced with the same choice
- Consider what your instinct or gut is telling you
 - Make the decision and commit to it

Communicating the decision:

- Plan how you are going to communicate the decision
 - Draw up a list of who needs to know, when will you tell them, how will you tell them
 - Rehearse how you will explain the decision to everyone who needs to know about it
